Ear Infections

Swimming sometimes gets a bad rap when talking about ear infections - not all ear infections are the same, most are caused by virus or bacteria and they are the most common. These types are generally treated with antibiotics and children are clear to come back to the pool when they no longer have a fever and are feeling better. The pool water will not affect the ear infection at all.

The other type is called swimmers ear, which is an infection that inflames the ear canal. This can be caused by bacteria or moisture in the canal. Most cases are treated with antibiotic ear drops. To prevent swimmers ear, make sure the canal is dry after swimming or bathing. Use a towel or hair dryer to completely dry the ear canal.
